
Replace Torch Switch

- 1. Strip back the 2 torch lead wires that connect to the torch switch approximately 1/4" (6 mm).
- 2. Trim the wires on the 005247 switch to approximately 1-1/2" (38 mm). Strip back the wires 1/4" (6 mm).
- Push the stripped torch lead wire into one end of one of the 074069 butt splices and push one of the 005247 trimmed and stripped switch leads in the other end of the butt splice, and crimp using a crimping pliers. Repeat the crimping process for the remaining 2 wires. Verify that the crimps are secure.
- 3. Slide the torch switch into the right-hand handle housing.



Replace Torch Trigger

- 1. Insert the 002299 torch trigger assembly into the torch handle housing as shown in the cut-away view below.
- 2. Verify that the torch trigger movement activates the torch switch push button.



Reassemble Torch

- 1. While positioning the handle halves together, be certain that the trigger pivots are properly inserted into the indents in the handle halves. Be careful not to pinch any wires..
- 2. Replace the 5 screws that secure the handle halves together. Refer to the figure on page 2, if necessary.
