Hypertherm Announces Acquisition of Leading Manufacturer and Supplier of Laser Consumables

HANOVER, N.H.—June 25, 2008—Hypertherm, the world leader in plasma arc cutting technology, today announced the acquisition of Italy based ESSE A Srl., a leading manufacturer and supplier of laser consumables and accessories. Financial terms are undisclosed.

This acquisition adds to Hypertherm's technology portfolio, manufacturing assets and customer base in laser cutting heads and consumables, while expanding Hypertherm's product offering to its growing base of global channel partners. In addition, it provides ESSE A with access to Hypertherm's significant technology resources and global operations and sales infrastructure. ESSE A, and its approximately 20 associates, will remain in Italy, where all of ESSE A's manufacturing facilities are located. Hypertherm does not plan any significant changes to its operations as a result of this purchase.

"The acquisition of ESSE A complements our current laser cutting business, strengthens our Centricut technology-based product offering, and expands our access to laser customers on the basis of ESSE A's proven reputation for high-quality products and superior service," said Hypertherm President Dick Couch.

"My partners and I are very excited to join the Hypertherm family," said ESSE A founder Stefano Achiluzzi. "I have had enormous respect for Hypertherm throughout my career and am certain this will result in exciting opportunities for both our associates and customers alike."
